

# At-Home Activities BINGO

## PS - March

Initial next to each activity your child completes at home this month. Return to the teacher at any time by March 27<sup>th</sup>. For each "BINGO" your child gets, he will be able to choose one sticker from our classroom sticker box!

Draw a picture to represent a Bible story from this month.	Play roll & build. Roll the dice & count out the same number of blocks. Add them to your tower.	Lay on your back and do some cloud watching. What pictures do you see in the clouds?	Mystery write! Adult writes letters in white crayon and white paper. Have your child paint over it with watercolors to reveal the letters.	Take a number walk. Can you find all the numbers 1-5?
Create a pattern using objects from nature. See if your child can copy the pattern. Extension: challenge your child to create his own pattern using the materials.	Write letters in chalk outside. Call out a letter and see if your child can hop to it.	Hunt for sticks and place them in order from longest to shortest.	Read a book together every night before bed for one week.	Lacing – lace beads, pasta, or cereal onto a string to make a necklace. BONUS: See if you can make a pattern!
Create your name using things you find in your backyard such as sticks, leaves, etc.	Look for shadows on your driveway and trace them with chalk.	Free Space	Take a street sign walk. Find one that begins with the same letter as your name	Create a pattern using objects from your house. See if your child can copy the pattern. Extension: challenge your child to create his own pattern using the materials.
Street sign scavenger hunt. See what street signs you can find in your neighborhood or while riding in the car.	Have a Palm Sunday parade! Wave palm branches (you could create your own) and act out the story of Jesus riding into Jerusalem!	Take a rainbow walk and look for something that matches each color of the rainbow.	Create a pattern using food. See if your child can copy the pattern. Extension: challenge your child to create his own pattern using the materials.	Family List! Make a list of everyone in your family with words and pictures!
Rainbow number write (numbers 1-5). Trace with every color of the rainbow!	Find some rocks and try to stack them. How many can you stack before they fall?	Shape tap. Someone calls out a shape. Then, someone else walks around and taps everything in the room that is that shape.	Help set the table and count how many utensils.	Write your name using a stick in the dirt.
