

At-Home Activities BINGO

TK - February

Initial next to each activity your child completes at home this month. Return to the teacher at any time by March 3rd. For each "BINGO" your child gets, he will be able to choose one sticker from our classroom sticker box!

Sight Word Chalk Jumping – draw sight words outside with chalk. Call them out and have your child jump to each one. (If it's too cold, draw on paper inside.)	Rhyming Scavenger Hunt – see how many items that rhyme your child can find around the house! BONUS: Take pictures & make a book!	Write letters on pieces of paper & hang around the room. Call out the letters and/or sounds & have your child run & tap it.	Writing Prompt – what would you look like if you were in a fairy tale? Draw a picture of you as a fairy tale character (prince/princess, fairy, dragon, etc.). Try to help your child sound out the word if possible.	Opposite Game – find an object you see & describe it (ex: I see a tall bookshelf) then your child responds with something she sees that is the opposite (ex: I see a short table).
Complete a puzzle together!	Draw a picture to represent a Bible story from this month.	Ending Sounds – say a word and see if your child can identify the sound at the end of the word.	Use stamps to spell your sight words!	Cutting Practice – Draw various lines for your child to cut along. Practice using correct scissors grip.
Read a book together every night before bed for one week.	Create a castle! You could use blocks, blankets, pillows, items from nature, whatever you want!	Free Space	Choose a letter your child struggles with & create a collage! Find the letter in magazines or newspapers. Cut it out & use the letters to create a collage.	Paper plate toss – write sight words on plates. Read them & throw them like Frisbees.
Retelling – Choose a favorite book/story. Read it together again & see if your child can retell it or act it out afterward. Provide prompts if needed.	Sight Words in Books – While reading together, see what sight words your child can point to in the book.	Lego Sight Words – write letters on Legos & build sight words!	Fine Motor Practice – painting with Qtips! Could also have child paint over letters, numbers, shapes, etc. & dot them with the Qtips.	Alphabet Maze – write letters on post-it's and create a maze in your house for your child to follow in ABC order!
Become Letters – Use your bodies to create letters. Could also spell your name, sight words, or other simple words using your bodies!	Bead Patterns – lace beads on a pipe cleaner or string to create a pattern!	Flashlight Numbers– tape numbers to wall or ceiling & turn off lights. Have child find & read with a flashlight.	Go Fish – make 2 sets of sight word cards & play Go Fish. Could also use words from previous units to review.	Read a book together every night before bed for one week.
