

At-Home Activities BINGO

TK - March

Initial next to each activity your child completes at home this month. Return to the teacher at any time by March 26th. For each "BINGO" your child gets, he will be able to choose one sticker from our classroom sticker box!

Draw a picture to represent a Bible story from this month.	Play roll & build. Roll the dice & count out the same number of blocks. Add them to your tower.	Lay on your back and do some cloud watching. What pictures do you see in the clouds?	Mystery write! Adult writes sight words in white crayon on white paper. Have your child paint over it with watercolors to reveal the word.	Take a number walk. When you see a number, tell the number that comes before and the number that comes after it.
Survey your family or friends, asking: what is your favorite color? Graph the results.	Take an alphabet walk. Choose a letter and find 5 things that begin with that letter.	Write sight words using a stick in the dirt.	Read a book together every night before bed for one week.	Lacing – lace beads, pasta, or cereal onto a string to make a necklace. BONUS: See if you can make a pattern!
Create your sight words using things you find in your backyard such as sticks, leaves, etc.	Look for shadows on your driveway and trace them with chalk.	Free Space	Take a street sign walk. Find one that begins with the same letter as your name	Retell a Bible story from this month. You can act it out, say it, draw it, or use pictures to help you sequence it.
Take a rainbow walk and look for something that matches each color of the rainbow.	Have a Palm Sunday parade! Wave palm branches (you could create your own) and act out the story of Jesus riding into Jerusalem!	Survey your family or friends, asking: what is your favorite pet? Graph the results.	Hunt for sticks and place them in order from longest to shortest.	Family List! Make a list of everyone in your family with words and pictures!
Rainbow number write (numbers 1-20). Trace with every color of the rainbow!	Find some rocks and try to stack them. How many can you stack before they fall?	Shape tap. Someone calls out a shape. Then, someone else walks around and taps everything in the room that is that shape.	Help set the table and count how many utensils.	Use a bag of animal crackers, colored goldfish, fruit snacks, or colored candy. Sort by type. Count how many of each & graph the results.
